Pierre Mongin will be appointed Executive Vice President, General Secretary, on 1 July 2015

Pierre Mongin, 60 years old, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of the RATP Group, graduated from the *Institut d'études politiques de Paris* with a master's degree in economics and studied at the *Ecole nationale d'administration* (ENA). He will join GDF SUEZ on 1 May 2015 as Executive Vice President. He will be appointed General Secretary on 1 July 2015, replacing Alain Chaigneau, who, wishing to claim his pension rights, will be appointed Special Advisor to Gérard Mestrallet on the same date.

Gérard Mestrallet, GDF SUEZ Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, said: "The professional experience of Pierre Mongin, who has successfully overseen a reorganisation of the RATP Group over the past nine years, will contribute valuably to the Group's transformation.
